The equipment is still in working condition, but rather worn out after 20 to 30 years of operation. The proposed WWTP improvements will upgrade equipment to improve operational reliability and efficiency. A minor capacity increase of approximately 30,000 gallons per day (gpd) will occur with flow equalization improvements. Notable upgrades are:

- A flow equalization tank
- New building containing new mechanical screens and grit removal
- Primary clarifier internals replacement
- Enlarge the sludge holding tank
- Sludge handling and pumping improvements
- Flow monitoring improvements
